

- Purpose of modification: To provide greater oil inlet capacity to transmission oil pump.

 - (3) Disassemble pump and drill four $\frac{3}{16}$ -inch holes in sides of pump housing at equally spaced intervals, at a distance of $1\frac{5}{16}$ -inches above the inside edge of the flange of the pump housing (fig. 1).
 - (4) Clean housing thoroughly, remove burrs and reassemble pump making sure that piston moves freely in the housing.
